

RYSA Spring Fling Classic 2017

KYSA and FIFA rules will apply with the following exceptions:

1. In the event of a tied game at the end of regulation time, players will remain on the field and go straight to a shoot out format. A coin flip will determine which team goes first. Away team will make the call. Five penalty kickers per team. The most goals scored after the five kicks for each team will be declared the winner. If the score remains tied, teams will alternate shooters from the remaining players until there is an unmatched goal between the teams. After all eligible players on the field of play have taken kicks, teams will start with their first kickers again and in the same order. (no player substitutions from the bench will be allowed; all kicks will be taken by players that are on the field at the end of regulation time)
2. Substitutes must be made from the mid field line and may only be made with the consent of the referee under the following conditions: After a goal by either team, before any goal kick, prior to a throw in by the substituting team, at the beginning of any period of play, after injury when the referee stops play and **after a caution, the cautioned player may be substituted.**
3. In accordance with FIFA policy: There shall be NO dissent between players and/or coaches and the referee. Questioning a referee's call is considered dissent. All coaches are urged to solicit the support of their fans in monitoring and enforcing this policy. Any player or coach ejected from a game will be ineligible to participate in the next (minimum of one game) scheduled game. No substitution will be allowed for the ejected player. Any red cards issued for fighting will result in a suspension for the remainder of the tournament. All red cards issued will be reported to Kentucky Youth Soccer Association.
4. Coaches are eligible for cards.
5. Parents are eligible for ejection from the park by the referee or any RYSA board member due to disorderly conduct and will not be allowed to return for the remainder of the tournament.
6. In the event of same uniform colors, the home team will be required to wear scrimmage vests which are available in the concession stand.
7. **All teams will be double elimination, if more than 10 teams, then single elimination will occur.**
8. **There will NOT be offside calls made in U-10 games.**
9. **Protests are NOT allowed.**
10. **Referee's decision is FINAL.**

Parking is not allowed in the grass and will be monitored by local law enforcement. Parents and Coaches, we ask that you help keep the park cleaning by picking up your area after your games.
